Dance

1. Nritya-katha(Dance on dialogues)

A single audio file(For example a good poem) would be given to all the participants on 11th or 12th of March and they have to do choreography on that same audio file and submit a one-take dance video before 11.59 Pm of 12th March. Performances can be either solo or duet.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Team Size: Solo/Duet
- Styles: Improvisation
- Judging Criteria: Choreography, Energy, Expressions, Clarity, Completion of Steps, and Overall impact.

Submission:

- Deadline for submission: 12th March
- Rename the recorded video as "Your name@Nritya-katha"
- Time limit: 2 - 5 minutes (including narration time)

General Rules:

- Only 1 entry is allowed per participant
- The video must be recorded from a static camera. Videos having multiple angles/moving cameras are strictly not allowed
- Note that the video should not be edited in any way. Use of any kind of special effects is STRICTLY prohibited and will lead to direct disqualification
- The decision of the judges shall be final and binding

Prizes:

- Winner - Rs. 1500
- 1st Runner up - Rs. 1000
- 2nd Runner up - Rs. 500

2. Izraz(Thematic Dance)

The participants would be given a theme to dance on. Participants can dance on only instrumental audios and voice-overs. Any type of dance form and props are allowed.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Team Size: 1-8 + Editors if needed
- Styles: Contemporary (Fusion of other western styles is allowed)
- Judging Criteria: Choreography, Concept and Depiction, Synchronization, Expressions, Costumes, Track Selection, Overall impact

Deadline for submission: 12th March

Theme: Social Issues

- Time limit: 3 - 5 minutes
- The performance necessarily has to be thematic
- Teams have to write a narration explaining their theme in not more than 150 words
- Rename the final video as "Team name@Izraz"

Guidelines to prepare your entry:

- Participants can choose to record a video in the following ways:
- Record videos individually from their respective places, and then these individual videos can be compiled to make a single entry.
- Use any video-conferencing platforms such as zoom to record the video
- Any other way you feel comfortable, but participants can't meet each other in person to record the videos together
- All the participants should appear on the screen together for at least 30 seconds.

General Rules:

- Adding additional elements in the video is not allowed. Use of any kind of special effects is strictly prohibited.
- Usage of props is allowed

Music

1. Heat the Beat (Beat making competition)

Compose a complete beat by Using anything literally. Best beats will be featured in Kyrat'22.

- Team Size: NA
- Judging Criteria: Accuracy of notes, Rhythm, selection of composition/original composition, Technique, Overall Impact

Deadline for submission: 12th March

- Time Limit: 2 - 4 minutes
- Rename the final video as "Team name@HeatTheBeat"

Prizes:

- Winner - Rs. 1500
- 1st Runner up - Rs. 1000

2. Rap it up (Rap singing competition)

A generic rap-singing competition. Original Lyrics would get more points in the judging.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Team Size: Solo
- Judging Criteria: Diction, Clarity of Words, Wit (Creativity, rhyme, etc.), Overall Impact (Attitude, etc), Improvisation and original lyrics would be awarded with extra points.
- Rename the final video as "Your name@Rapitup"

Deadline for submission: 12th March

General Rules:

- Only 1 entry is allowed per participant
- The language of rap must be only English and/or Hindi.
- Backing tracks are allowed. Audio cannot be processed or altered after recording
- The participant is allowed to use puns, double entendres and quips, but any sort of racist, sexist, or offensive slurs will lead to disqualification.
- Note that the video should not be edited in any way. Use of any kind of special effects is STRICTLY prohibited and will lead to direct disqualification.

Fine Arts/Digital Art

1. Freedom of canvas (draw anywhere but paper)

You always have the freedom of choosing your own canvas. So pick yours and paint on anything but paper, like shoes, or wall, phone covers, bottles, coffee mug, or anything.

- Team Size: Solo
- Judging Criteria: Creativity, technique, theme incorporation, complexity, neatness, overall impact

Deadline for submission: 12th March

Submission:

- Click photos of at least 3 stages of your art - Initial, half-done, and final work.

- Record a video of at least 45 seconds while working. The artwork and the participant should be clearly visible in the video. Note that the video should be 'one-shot, no-transition'.

General Rules:

- Only 1 entry is allowed per participant.
- Use of unfair means, explicit content or references is prohibited and shall lead to immediate disqualification.
- Note that the video should not be edited in any way. Use of any kind of special effects is STRICTLY prohibited and will lead to direct disqualification.

2.Comic Kaun

Create a sequence of narrative stories i.e. An original comic strip with your own awesome characters be it a superhero, manga, slice of life, or anything.

- Judging Criteria: Creativity, quality, originality, composition and layout, visual impact

Deadline for submission: 12th March

- The resolution of the frame must be 1080x1080 (1 : 1 aspect ratio).
- This is a design competition wherein participants have to create a comic series of 4-9 panels in a single strip.

General Rules:

- Any sign of plagiarism may lead to disqualification.
- Click photos of at least 3 stages of your art - Initial, half-done, and final work.
- Record a video of at least 45 seconds while working. The artwork and the participant should be clearly visible in the video. Note that the video should be 'one-shot, no-transition'.

Prizes:

Winner - Rs. 2000

1st Runner up - Rs. 1500

2nd Runner up - Rs. 1000

3. Impressions(Recreational Art)

Participants have to recreate any famous/legendary painting with their own style giving their own touch. You can put your own spice using acrylic, charcoal, oil pastel, or anything.

- Team Size: N.A.
- Judging Criteria: Creativity, finishing, uniqueness, overall impact.

Deadline for submission: 12th March

- Click photos of at least 3 stages of your art - Initial, half-done, and final work.
- Record a video of at least 45 seconds while working. The artwork and the participant should be clearly visible in the video. Note that the video should be 'one-shot, no-transition'.

General Rules:

- Use of unfair means, explicit content or references is prohibited and shall lead to immediate disqualification.
- Note that the video should not be edited in any way. Use of any kind of special effects is STRICTLY prohibited and will lead to direct disqualification.

4. Animus (Draw what you imagine)

You will be given a Paragraph write up. Make the artwork by imagining the scenery, the characters all by yourself.

- Click photos of at least 3 stages of your art - Initial, half-done, and final work.
- Record a video of at least 45 seconds while working. The artwork and the participant should be clearly visible in the video. Note that the video should be 'one-shot, no-transition'.

General Rules:

- Use of unfair means, explicit content or references is prohibited and shall lead to immediate disqualification.
- Note that the video should not be edited in any way. Use of any kind of special effects is STRICTLY prohibited and will lead to direct disqualification.

5. Jashn-e-waste(Upcycling the waste)

Judging Criteria: Creativity, technique, complexity, neatness, overall impact.

Deadline for submission: 12th March

Submission:

- Click photos of at least 3 stages of your art - Initial, half-done, and final work.
- Record a video of at least 45 seconds while working. The artwork and the participant should be clearly visible in the video. Note that the video should be 'one-shot, no-transition'.
- Use of unfair means, explicit content or references is prohibited and shall lead to immediate disqualification.

6. Crossover(Crossover Poster)

Combine two content pieces (any two Movies, Shows, Books, or Music Album Art) where you take the visual styles, aesthetics, characters, elements, etc., and merge them in a way that the original visual language of each piece is clearly identifiable. The medium is restricted to digital art only.

- Team Size: NA
- Judging Criteria: Originality, creativity, visibility and quality of elements

Deadline for submission: 12th March

You need to give a title and a description to the poster too.

General Rules:

- Participants can use additional COPYRIGHT FREE images.
- Some sources of copyright free images are Pexels.com, Unsplash.com, Pixabay.com, Stocksnap.io, Burst.shopify.com, Negativespace.co.
- Any sign of plagiarism may lead to disqualification.
- Your design should not convey any racist, political or religious messages.
- Obscenity of any kind is not allowed and will lead to immediate disqualification.

Drama

1. Marionette (Monologue) (Solo Acting):

The participants will have to send a maximum of 5 min video of them enacting a scene. Creativity is welcomed; you can create your own dialogues to enact.

3. **Deadline for submission :** 12th March
4. **Submission rules (online) :**

- Time: 2 to 5 minutes

- Record the video and rename it as – “Your name@Marionette”

7. GENERAL RULES :

- The act can be in either Hindi or English or both. Creativity is welcome, you can write your own dialogues and enact.

Speaking Arts

Fashion Events

1. In Vogue(Cosplay Competition)
